HPOG by the Numbers: Speaker Notes

- This is a snapshot of the main, five-year HPOG goals, where progress was around this time last year, and where it stood at the end of June.
- HPOG continues to make progress across many goals, as you can see on the screen.
 - Our TANF percentage of enrollment stayed at 20%
 - We've seen great increases that we know are due to your hard work. Of note, the largest increases can be seen in basic skill completions, healthcare occupational training starts and completions.
- We are hopeful that the end of Year 4 through Year 5 will see increased completions of healthcare occupational training and healthcare employment.
